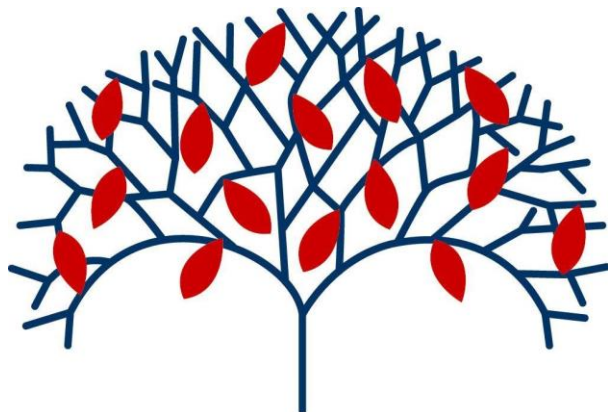

The time has come to say goodbye.

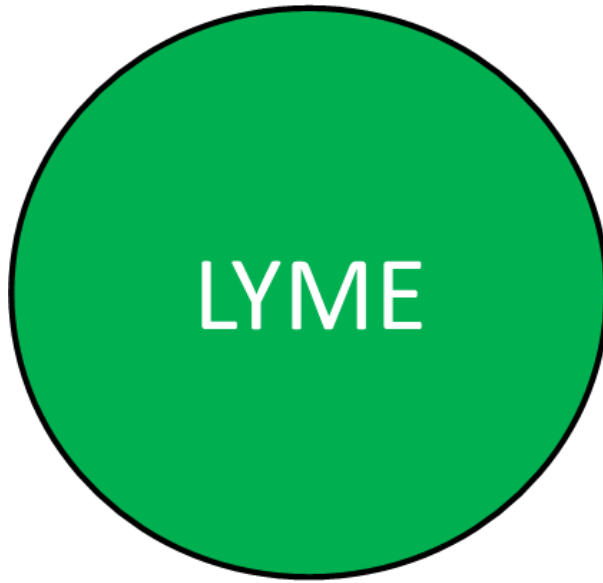
Our year has come to an end.

Have helped in some small way.

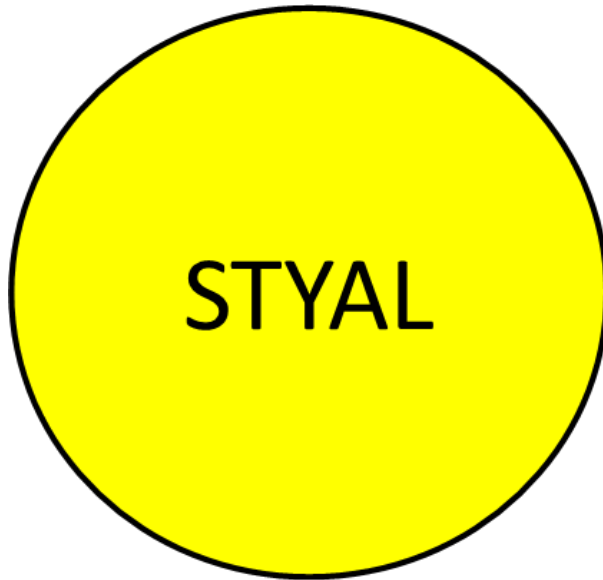
We have read such a lot of stories
