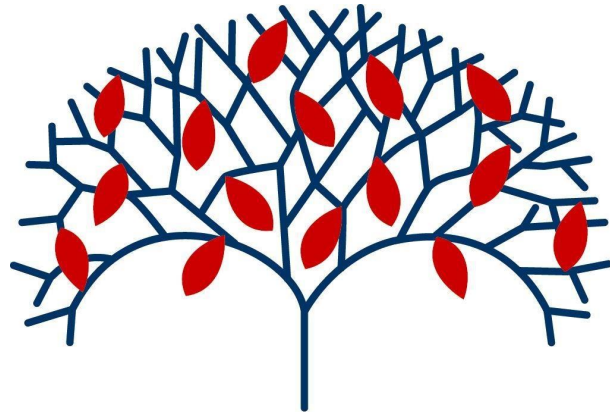

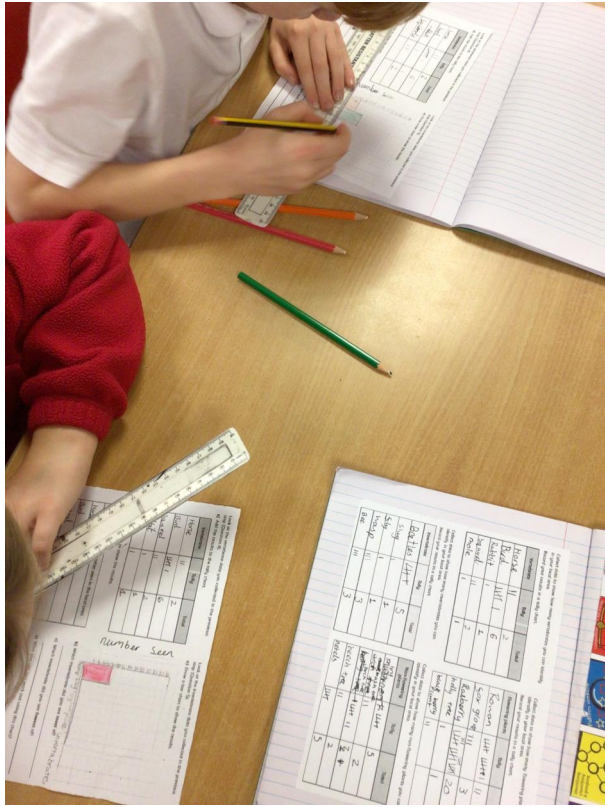
and positive attitude on the pitch were a joy to watch, and they represented the school with pride.

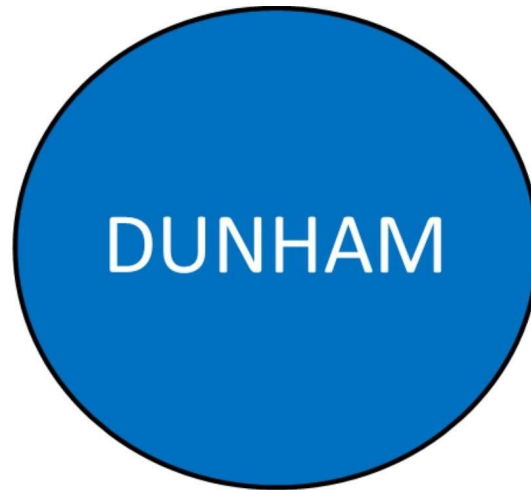




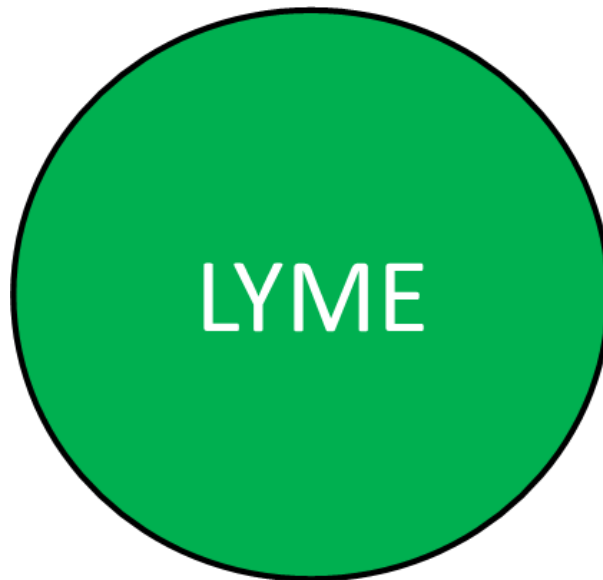




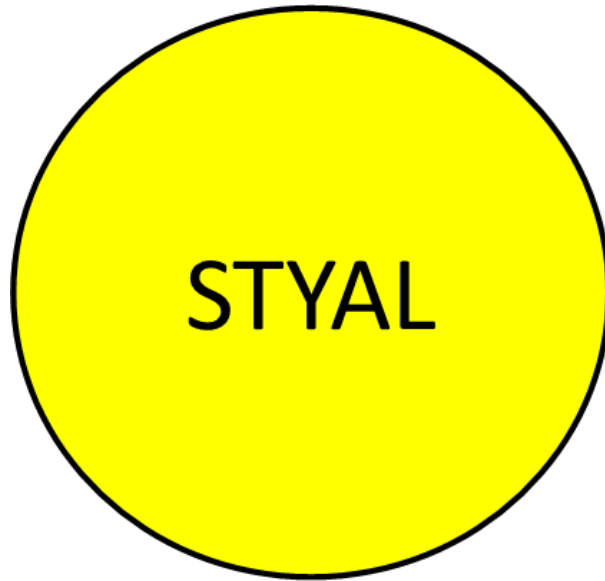
