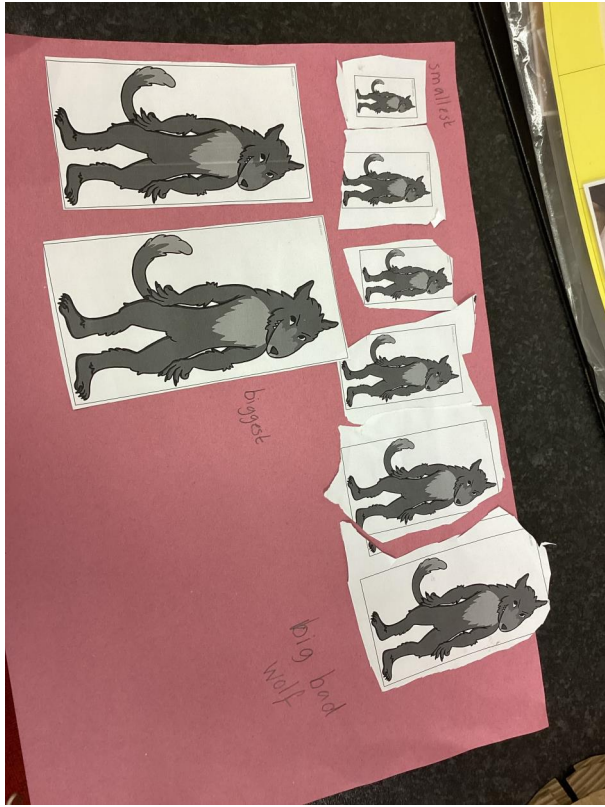
Spotlight on Learning - Reception

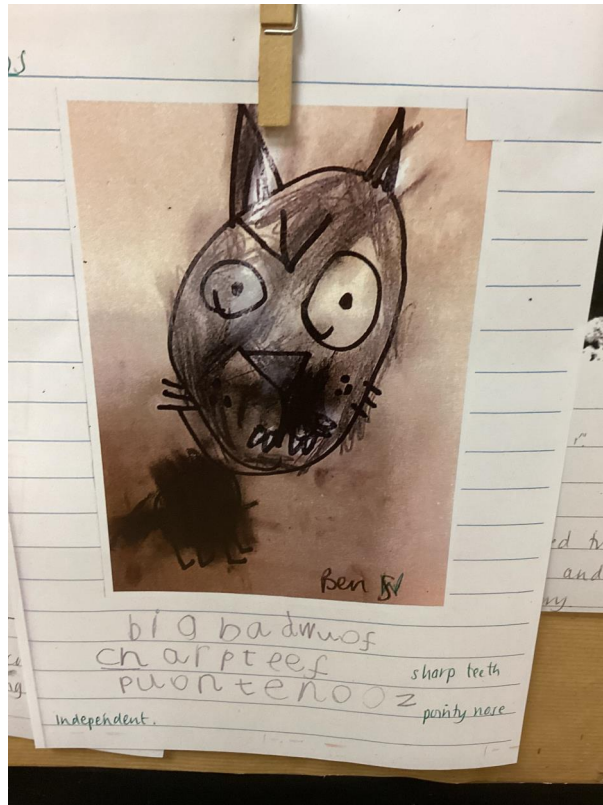












Our Forest School

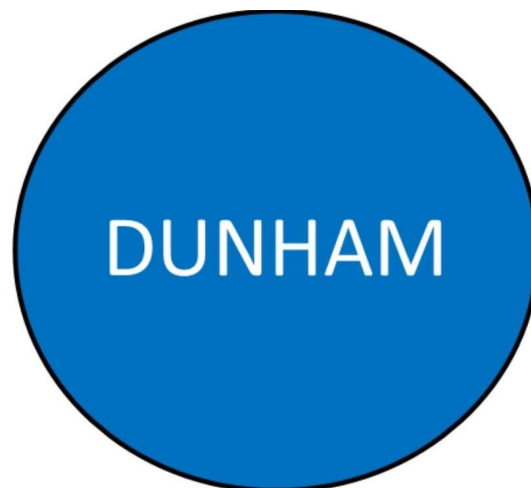

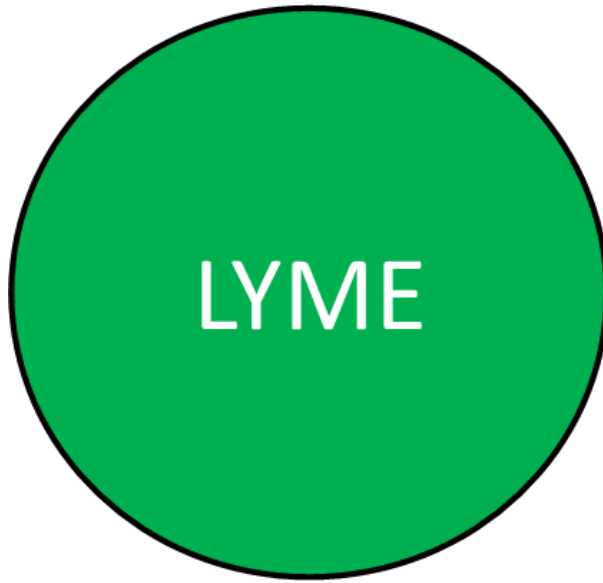

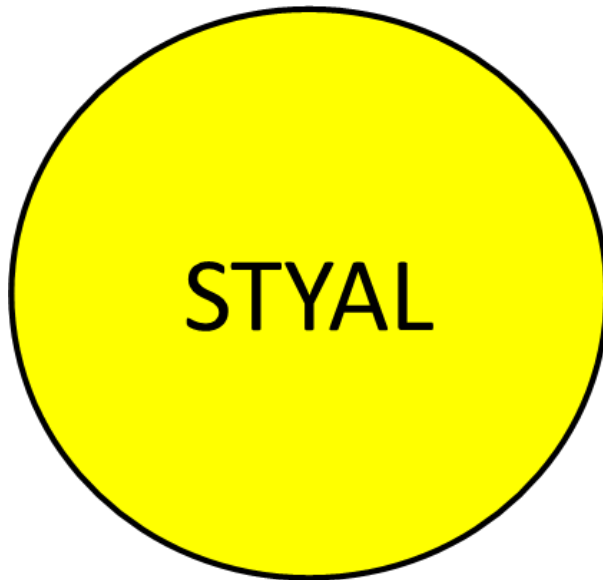
