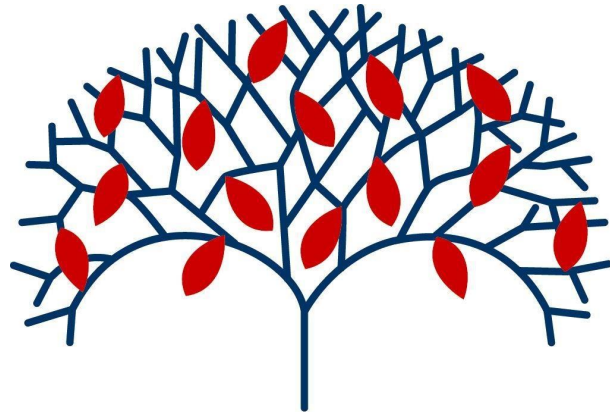

Spotlight on Learning - Year 3

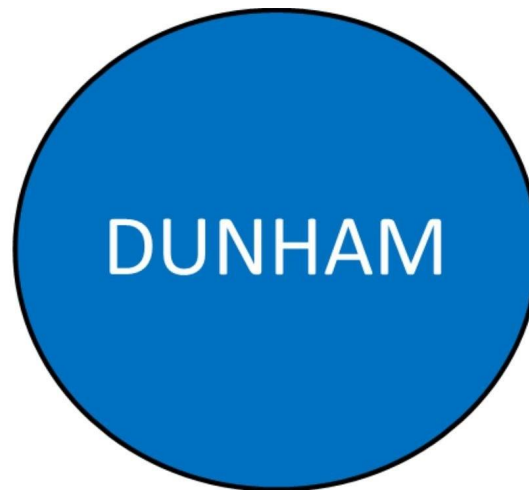




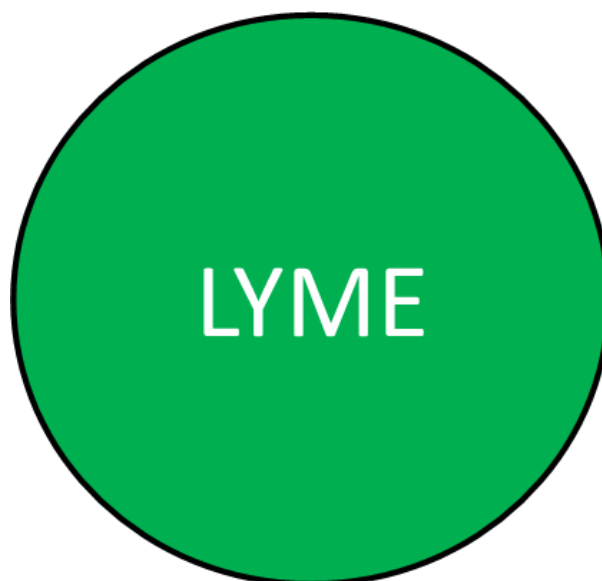
In maths, we have become *exchange masters*, confidently using 3-digit column addition and subtraction. Everyone has worked brilliantly to understand when to exchange and how to set the calculations out clearly. In English, we have been exploring our class story, *Winter's Child*. We learned all about the main character and discussed how he changes the world around

him. Now we are getting ready to plan and write our very own versions of the story, filled with imagination and excitement. In DT, we have been practising making different moving mechanisms, including levers and sliders. These skills are helping us prepare to design our own moving creations linked to the theme of recycling. In Science, we have been learning about what makes a balanced diet; we loved exploring cereal packets and using the traffic light system to check the amount of sugar in each one. We have been particularly interested in the different diets that people have (omnivorous, vegetarian, pescatarian and vegan) and enjoyed deigning our own balanced meals for each one. A particular highlight of this term has been our lessons on stop frame animation. It has been so exciting to see our storyboards come to life in the form of short animations made using the iMotion app.

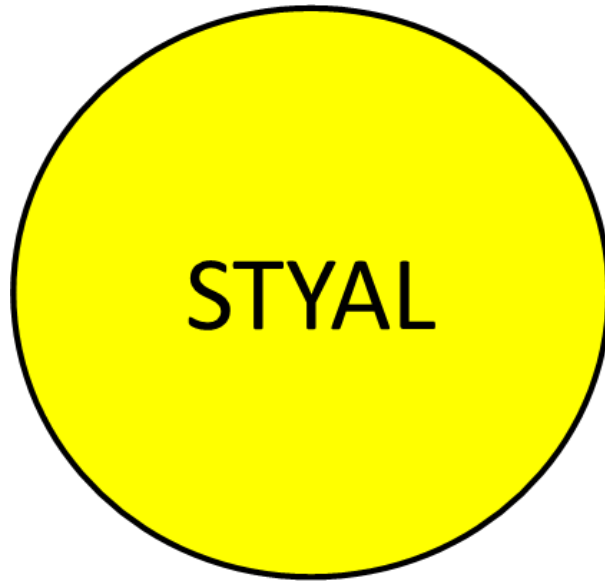
