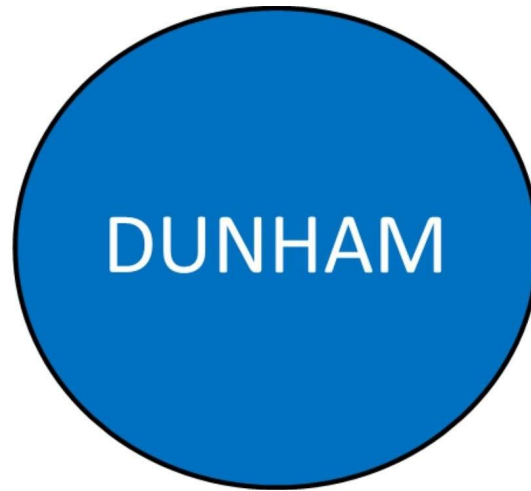




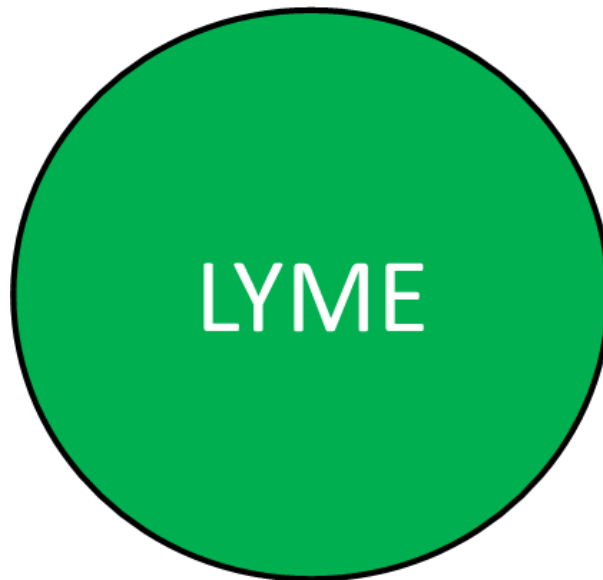
Carols Around the Tree

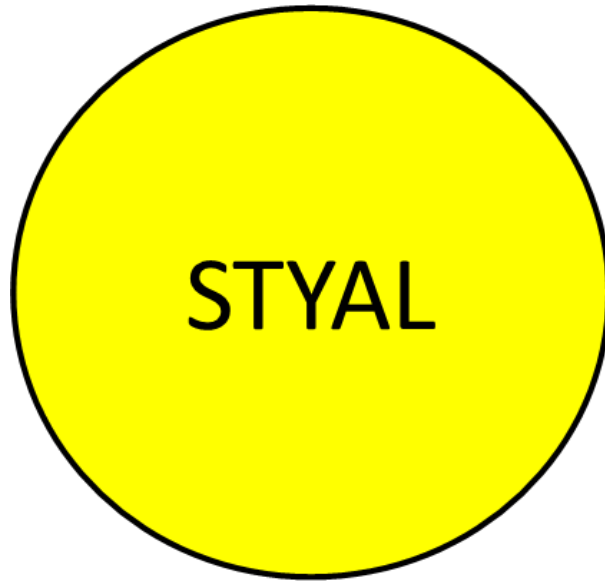

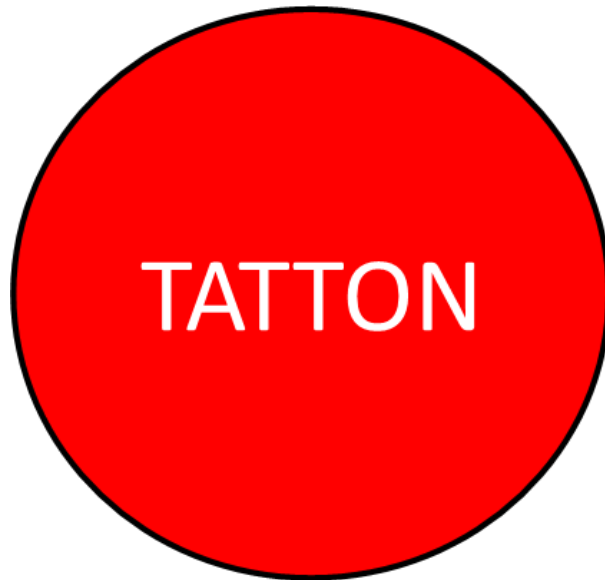
