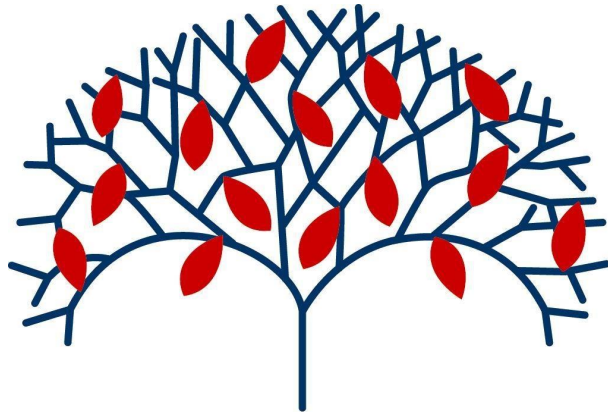

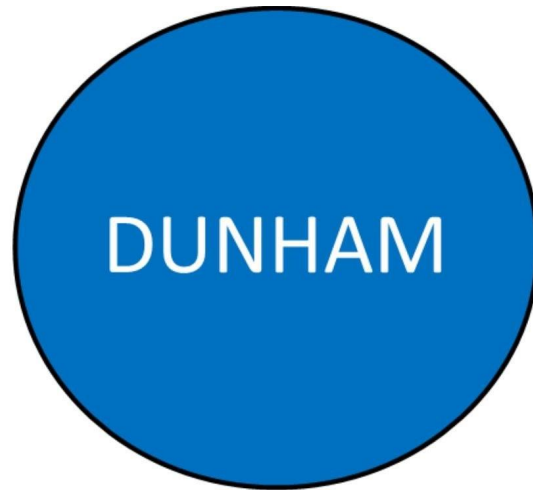
Reading Millionaires

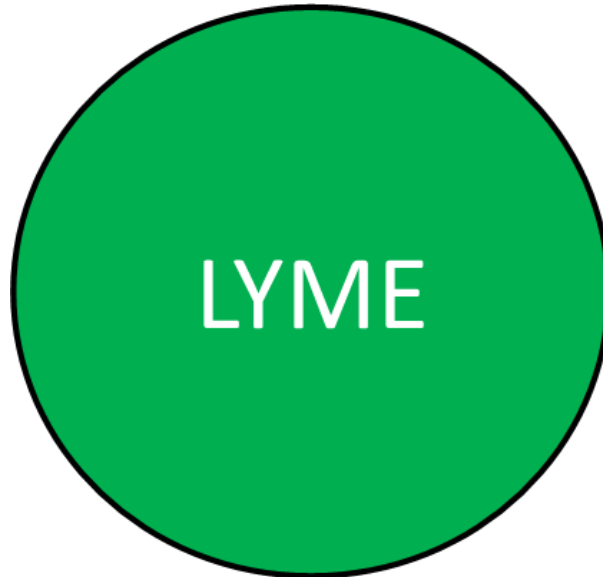
Reaching one million words is a momentous occasion, and we are so proud of their commitment to reading - well done to all of our Reading Millionaires!

We look forward to celebrating more Reading Millionaires in the future!

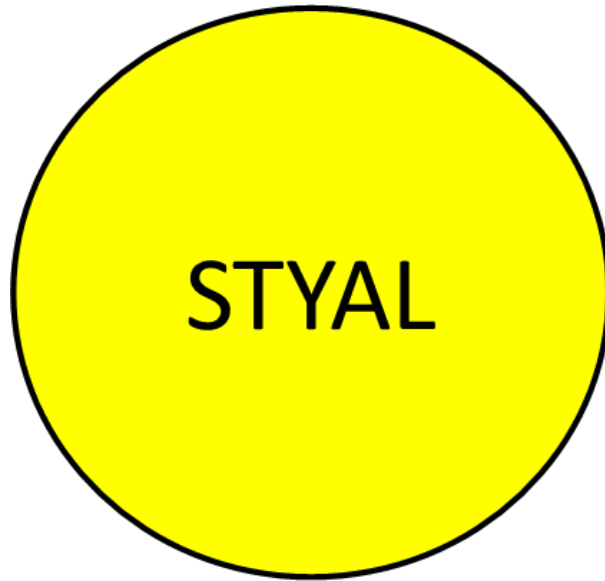
