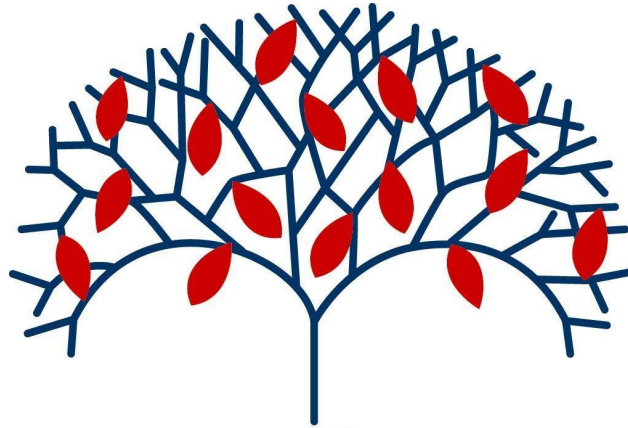

## Year 1/2 Trip to Peak Wildlife Park

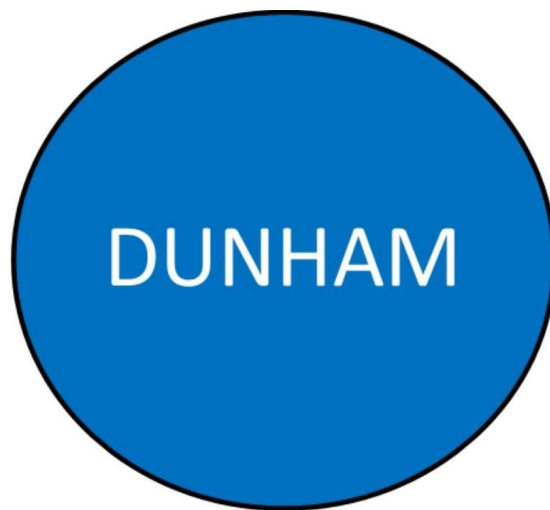

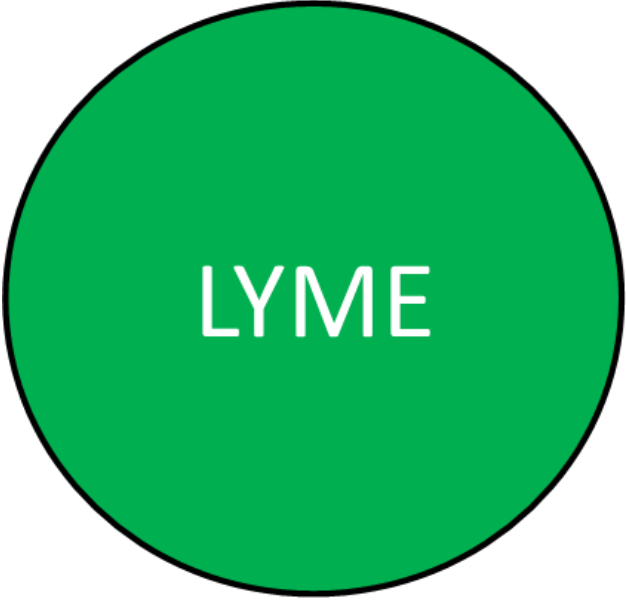




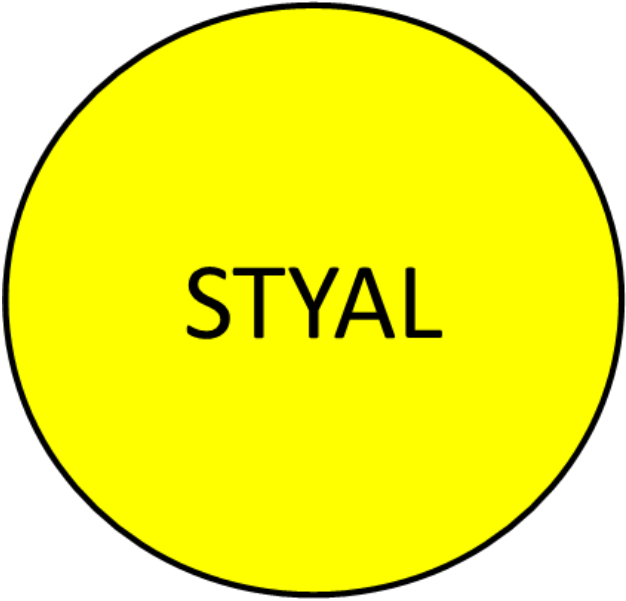
