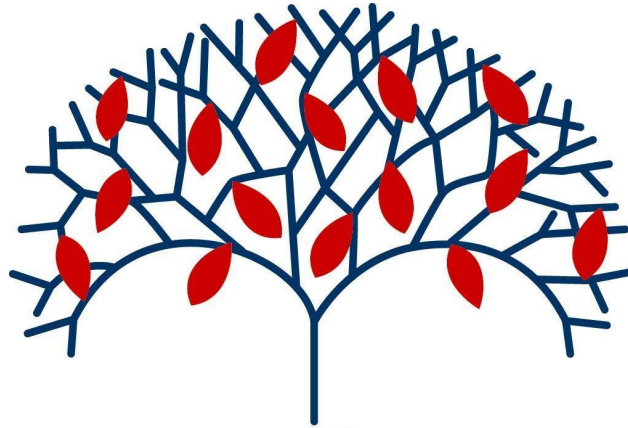

Well done to all who participated - we are proud of you all!

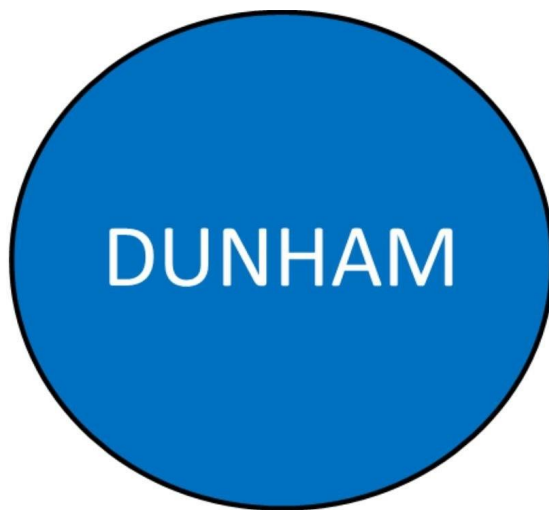
Year 6 Production of 'Ye-Ha!'

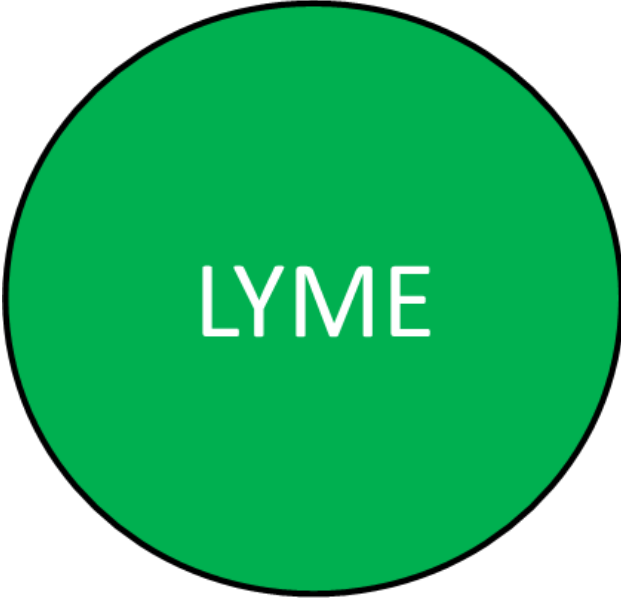

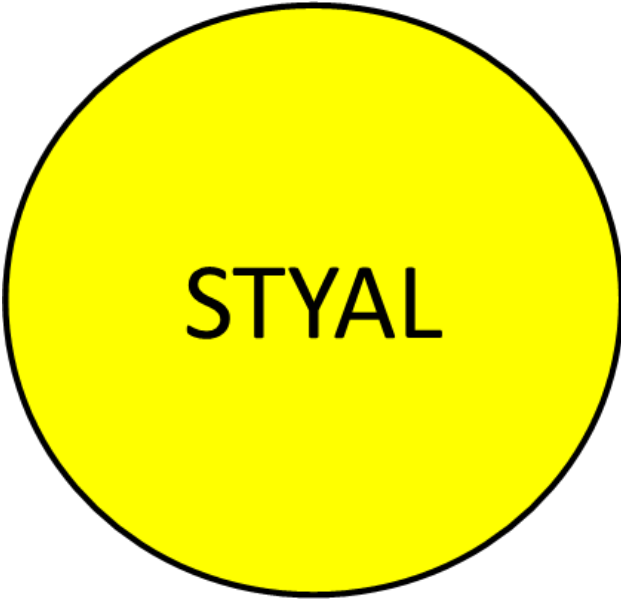
