



Musical Opportunities at Lindow

Music is a key part of our curriculum and plays a vital role in enriching the lives of pupils at Lindow Community Primary School.

Each class has a weekly curriculum music lesson with their teacher. We follow the National Curriculum, using a variety of instruments to explore and combine sounds. We love composing music, creating our own pieces and performing them to the rest of the class and to partner classes.

Singing forms an important part of school life at Lindow. We enjoy singing together throughout the school year and love to celebrate and perform on special occasions and at key points in the school calendar, including Remembrance, Harvest and Christmas. We believe that singing together helps to build confidence, community and a shared sense of belonging.

We also receive funding from the Love Music Trust to allow all Year 5 pupils to learn an instrument for a term. This year, the Year 5 children will build on their learning from the previous year when playing the Ukulele.

There are many musical opportunities at Lindow Community Primary School, including our school choir, who have the exciting opportunity to take part in Young Voices, giving children the chance to perform alongside thousands of other children in a spectacular concert.

Signing is also an important part of our musical life at Lindow, reflecting and celebrating our deaf awareness culture. We embrace signing alongside singing where possible, helping to make our music inclusive and accessible and ensuring that all children can participate and enjoy making music together.

We also offer many opportunities beyond class lessons for children to learn to play a musical instrument with one of our highly qualified peripatetic teachers.
