### Throughout the Week

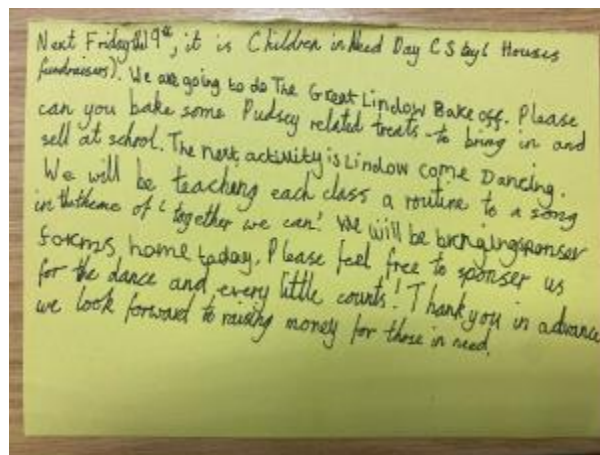
In classes, children at Lindow will be thinking about and exploring how one kind word leads to another.
